CURRY PARK CAMPGROUND RULES

Campground users are responsible for reading and understanding Park Rules

- 1. The following regulations have been adopted by the City of Ironwood to ensure that the Curry Park facilities are as enjoyable as possible for all visitors.
- All Campers MUST register via website <u>Curry Park Campground City of Ironwood</u>
 (<u>ironwoodmi.gov</u>) prior to occupying their site. Check in time is 2 p.m or later on arrival date and check out is Noon on departure date.
- 3. Reservations cancelled with greater than 48-hours notice will be refunded all prepaid fees EXCEPT (1) NIGHT. Less than 48-hours notice and No-shows forfeit all prepaid fees.
- 4. Camping will be permitted only in established campground sites or in areas designated by a park attendant.
- 5. Not more than one recreational unit, occupied by a single family, will be permitted on an individual site. No individual or family shall occupy more than one camp site. Only one individual or family may reserve a site and the reserved site shall not be sublet or transferred to any other party for any purpose. Unoccupied, reserved campsites shall not be utilized by any other camper unless authorized by a park officer.
- 6. Quiet Hours must be observed between 10:00 P.M. and 8:00 A.M. non-registered visitor hours: 7:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. All users of park facilities shall conduct themselves in a manner that does not create excessive noise or disturb and annoy others.
- 7. No fireworks allowed within the park.
- 8. PET FRIENDLY RULES: Pets (with the exception of service animals) must be under immediate control by the owner and on a leash at all times. Pet owners will be responsible for any damages or injuries caused by their pets. Pets should not be left in campers or tied up unattended to prevent barking from negatively affecting the camping experience of other visitors. The owner of any pet must ensure that any droppings are cleaned up immediately and disposed of properly.
- 9. Campsites must be kept clean and waste deposited in dumpster provided.
- 10. A camping unit is defined as a motor home, camping trailer, modified camper van/bus, pop-up tent or camping tent. Camping units must be street legal, in good working order and have a presentable appearance. Camping in a passenger vehicle is not permitted for more than one night and must be approved by the Campground Hosts.
- 11. Containers must be kept under trailer drains and emptied only at places designated. No waste lines shall be permitted to drain to the ground surface.
- 12. No diapers, cans, or other trash shall be deposited in the restroom.
- 13. There shall be no bathing, cleaning, dishwashing, or other similar activity at any water faucet.
- 14. No hoses or water supply lines shall be connected to hydrants.
- 15. Fires shall only be built in designated fire rings.
- 16. Persons shall not destroy, damage, or remove City property, trees, shrubs, wildflowers, or other vegetation and may not cut trees in park boundaries for firewood.
- 17. Ground cover may not exceed the length and width of the RV's awning.
- 18. No nails, bolts, or screws will be allowed in site markers.
- 19. Children must be kept under supervision by a parent or responsible adult.

- 20. ORV'S as defined by the State of Michigan are permitted under the following conditions: they must be operated in a safe and prudent manner, they must be operated in compliance with all State of Michigan Laws, operation of the ORV does not exceed a speed of 5 mph. ORV use by registered campers is limited to entering or exiting the Park from their camping site.
- 21. Persons may not operate or park a motor vehicle anywhere except on designated roads or parking areas. The speed limit shall be obeyed as posted.
- 22. During the camping season, persons shall not discharge or operate firearms, air guns, slingshots, crossbows or bow and arrow, and there shall be no hunting, trapping, killing or intentionally disturbing wildlife within park boundaries.
- 23. There shall be NO washing of vehicles, campers, or boats.
- 24. Absolutely NO feeding of any wildlife in the park.
- 25. Dump station and/or Water Tank Fills cost \$15.00 each use.
- 26. Dumpster is for registered campers use only.
- 27. Campground Hosts are authorized to move campers as deemed necessary and appropriate.
- 28. In case of an emergency dial 911.
- **At the Park Host's discretion, violations of any of these rules may result in eviction from park without any refund of camping fees.

Park users agree to protect, indemnify, and save harmless the City of Ironwood and their agents, servants, and employees from and against all causes of action, claims, demands, suits, liability, or expense by reason of loss or damage to any property or bodily injury to any person, including death, as a direct or indirect result of the identified use or uses of the park.
